Paul Henkin/Suzanne Fisher Scholarship

Getting to the CASP Convention can be difficult for graduate students and first-year school psychologists.

Former CASP member Paul Henkin had a passion for working with children and helping them achieve their full potential. He believed that new psychologists would be best served by the workshops and other information available at the conferences; thus, the creation of the Paul Henkin Scholarship.

Suzanne Fisher was the Executive Director of CASP from 1999-2012. She had a passion for the annual convention, believing that all school psychologists should attend to ensure that they are kept up to date on the latest information about the profession. She knew that if students would attend the annual convention they would likely make this a “must-attend” event.

The award, up to the amount of \$750, is made annually to CASP members; one to a graduate student in school psychology, and one to a newly credentialed school psychologist (must have received your credential within the last three years). It is to be used to attend the annual convention and funds are to be applied toward registration and workshop costs, lodging and transportation.

Scholarship applications are evaluated based on evidence of knowledge of the demands of the vocation of school psychology as well as an understanding of the importance of continuing professional development.
